Calendar & Schedule: The school year, which is divided into two semesters, has 178 days. During the 2018-2020 school years Parkway West utilized a hybrid schedule which combined blocked and traditional scheduling and allowed students to take seven courses per semester, explore deeper levels of academic content areas, and prepare for a college schedule. For the 2020-2021 school year West shifted to quarters with students taking 4 classes per quarter. Quarter 1 and 2 were full virtual. **Beginning the 2021-2022** school year West High's schedule will consist of all block classes with a built in Academic Lab.

Special Programs: Parkway West High is the site of a comprehensive program for Deaf and Hard of Hearing Students as well as the MOSAICS program for exceptionally and highly gifted students. Students are offered the opportunity to apply to the SPARK! program which is an immersion-based student learning experience where they can engage, partner and work collaboratively with business partners and community leaders to develop and design their educational goals and learning process. Additionally, West partners with South Technical School to provide students with a ½ day program which provides students with career and technical education that prepares them for continuing education and the workforce.
