Three Parkway schools have been named State Schools of Character for their dedicated focus on character development. Congratulations to Central Middle, South Middle and the Early Childhood Center!




Best in Music

South High's Library Takes Exemplary Library Program Award

Congratulations to South High's library and its media specialists, Dawn Murray and Katie Pendleton, for being named one of nine libraries in the state to receive the Exemplary Library Program award from the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education (DESE).

The award highlights the library program for its commitment, collaboration and engagement with its students and staff in several areas of literacy. Katie and Dawn engage readers with their

nationally known Library Lit Loot program that provides a personalized monthly themed subscription box for students and staff throughout the school year and summer. The award recognizes their commitment to social and emotional literacy through offerings like Mental Health Awareness Week, Wellness Wednesday AcLab, and Staff Wellness Makerspace Days. Finally, their innovations in technology and digital literacy include collaboration with St. Louis County Library, their recent addition of augmented reality to the Senior Art Show, and their high level of collaboration with teachers in the classroom.

Katie and Dawn are seen as true leaders beyond their library by presenting their innovative programming at the local, state, national, and international levels. To earn this recognition, libraries must provide evidence for 21 indicators across five main categories, including instruction, leadership, library environment, library management and staffing.


