

Personal Device Connection Directions

PHONES

Apple Devices – Got to **Settings** and select **Wi-Fi**. Select **Parkway**. Next enter user credentials as listed below:

Username: Type in your **Network user ID** (Not your Google ID)

Password: Type in your **Network user Password** (Not your Google password)

Click on **Join** button

Certificate window opens – Just click on **Trust** in upper right corner

Device should now connect

Android Devices – Got to **Settings** and select **Connections** then **Wi-Fi**. Select **Parkway**. Next enter user credentials as listed below:

EAP Method: **PEAP** should be selected

Phase 2 authentication: Select the drop down arrow and choose **MSCHAPv2** if available

CA Certificate: Select - **Do not Validate**

Identity: Type in your **Network user ID** (Not your Google ID)

Anonymous Identity: Leave blank (You may have to scroll down)

Password: Type in your **Network user password** (Not your Google password)

Select **Connect** and device should now connect

PERSONAL LAPTOPS & TABLETS

Windows - Only Windows 7 & 10 Professional or Enterprise OS versions will connect to our Network. Windows Home, Home Premium or Ultimate OS versions will NOT connect to our Network.

To connect: On the bottom RIGHT of taskbar, left-click the wireless icon and select **Parkway** and select Connect. Window opens to enter your **Network User ID** and **Network user Password**. (Not your Google ID or password) Click **OK**.

A “Windows Security Alert” window may open – Just select **Connect** and device should now connect

Chrome Books – Click on **Parkway**. A window will open with the SSID at the top. Next enter the user credentials as listed below:

EAP Method – select **PEAP**

Phase 2 Authentication – select **MSCHAPv2**

Server CA Certificate – Select **Do Not Check**

Enter **Network user ID** and **Network user Password** (Not your Google ID and password)

Make sure to check the box – **Save Identity and Password**, then click **Connect** and device should now connect

Apple Mac Books – Go to **Wi-Fi Settings** icon on the taskbar (top right) and select **Parkway**.

Enter users **Network user ID** and **Network user Password** (Not your Google ID and password) and click **OK**.

A “Verify Certificate” window may open – Just select **Continue** and device should now connect

Apple iPad – Go to **Settings** and select **Wi-Fi**. Select **Parkway**. Next enter the user credentials as listed below:

Username: Type in your **Network user ID** (Not your Google ID)

Password: Type in your **Network user Password** (Not your Google password)

Click on **Join** button

Certificate window opens – Just click on **Trust** in upper right corner

Device should now connect
