## Special Acknowledgement

Dr. LaFever, Mr. Kramer, Mrs. Crossett and Mr. Snow traveled to Washington, DC this past summer to accept Parkway North's Green Ribbon School award. North High and McKelvey Elementary are among the 2017 U.S. Department of Education Green Ribbon Schools award honorees. Parkway received two of only three awards for Missouri schools, and *North is the only high school in the nation to be recognized!*

Across the country, 45 schools, nine districts, and nine postsecondary institutions were honored for their innovative efforts to reduce environmental impact and utility costs, improve health and wellness, and ensure effective sustainability education.

North High has a deep-rooted commitment to whole school sustainability. We have worked to make our physical place, organizational culture, and educational programs more sustainable. For many years, North has been on the forefront of integrating environmentally preferable procedures into the everyday operating practices of the building. In most cases, these enhancements have been a direct response to student-driven initiatives, ranging from single-stream recycling programs, community clothing drop-off boxes, a shoe drive water project, composting for food scrap and compostable serviceware, river cleanup crews, rain gardens, and native prairie gardens.

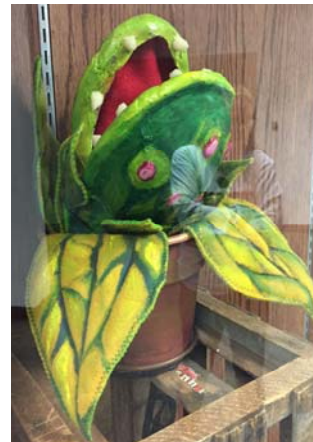

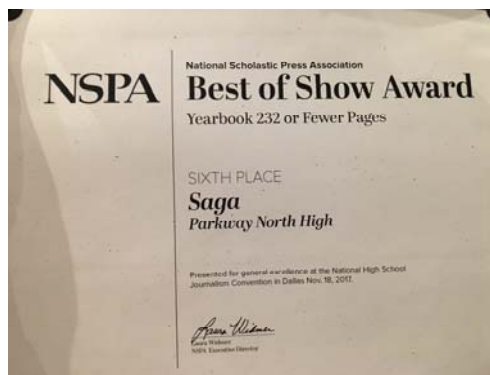

## The College Corner

### Christy Wills, College, Career & Transition Counselor



#### **Seniors—Very Important!**

If you have a college application that is due between January 1 and January 15, 2018, you MUST complete your request and submit materials to the guidance office no later than Monday, December 18, in order to assure that we have time to process it properly.

#### **Just a Reminder: Application Processing**

When you are ready to send your application(s) to the college(s) of your choice, please follow these procedures:

1. If you are applying to a Common App school, please notify your recommenders. All Common App schools require transcripts, forms, and rec letters electronically. Please see Mrs. Larsen or Ms. Wills with any Common App questions.
2. Complete the official Transcript Release Form!
3. Indicate any deadlines on your Naviance requests.

If you require a counselor recommendation, you must complete the Recommendation Survey (in detail) at *least* TEN school days prior to when you need your application sent or mailed.

Please note: It is your responsibility to be aware of admission, financial aid, scholarship, housing, etc. deadlines for each college and university you are interested in attending.

#### **Scholarships**

Each year Guidance receives independent scholarship applications. Visit the **counseling website>College Planning>Scholarships and Financial Aid** to see if you qualify for any of these awards. Deadlines are approaching. For additional scholarships, check out: [www.fastweb.com](http://www.fastweb.com) (Fastweb has a new, free app you can download to your smart phone!), [www.savingforcollege.com](http://www.savingforcollege.com) or [www.scholarships.com](http://www.scholarships.com).

#### **Mid-Year Reports**

For students who have applied via Common App, your mid-year reports will be sent automatically. For students using a university online portal, schools will send an email notifying your recommenders that a mid-year report is due. No notification is necessary on your part.

#### **College Credit**

Seniors can earn college credit at a reduced tuition rate this school year. In some circumstances, seniors can have non-essential classes removed from their schedule to pursue college credit. Requirements are 3.0 minimum GPA, manageable high school course load, and at least 8-10 hours per week for internet college work. #### **Freshmen**

There are many supports available to freshman students. Every freshman is participating in lessons to build study and organization skills. Students should visit teachers when they need help. Ask your student about their academic lab plans every B day! Most teachers have a website or Google Classroom with homework assignments and class information. Teachers may be available to help before or after school with a scheduled appointment. The CLC is open for study and computer use after school, Monday-Thursday.

Is your student doing well in a subject? Ready for a bigger challenge? Perhaps your student should be moved into the honors section of the course at the start of 2<sup>nd</sup> semester. Placement depends on teacher recommendation and space availability, but please have your student discuss this with their current teacher.

#### **Sophomores**

Sophomores recently continued exploration of life after high school. They completed a survey, "Do What You Are," an adaptation of the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator. This is used for personality assessment and career counseling, and shows tendencies of being Extroverted or Introverted, Intuitive or Sensing, Perceptive or Judging, Thinking or Feeling. From this, students can read about job responsibilities that match their tendencies.

These surveys were completed on each student's Naviance Family Connections account. The results and opportunity to review careers, projected openings and wages are available until the student graduates! You can review your student's results as well: go to the PNH website, Counseling, and Naviance. # 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens

## For Parents:

In freshman and sophomore leadership labs, students are learning about *The 7 Habits of Highly Effective Teens* throughout the year. We are currently introducing **Habit 3—Put First Things First** to freshmen, and deepening sophomores' understanding of this habit. Habit 3 focuses on life management: your purpose, values, roles, and priorities. Talk with your child about how to organize their time and prioritize daily and weekly activities. Helping your child understand the difference between "important" vs. "urgent" is a great life skill. One way to do this is to ask your child to make a list of what they think is their greatest time waster and what to do about it.

Another way to support your child is to check Infinite Campus and have a conversation about missing assignments, long-term projects and upcoming tests, and make a plan for completion that takes into account all of their academic/extracurricular obligations.

Freshmen will also be introduced to **Habit 4—Think Win-Win**. This is the belief that everyone can win. It's not me or you but *WE*. Thinking win-win encourages conflict resolution and helps individuals seek mutually beneficial solutions. For example, setting clear expectations about chores, curfew, grades, car privileges, etc. is important, because it is hard for you both to win if you are playing by different rules.

At a recent staff meeting, Julie Lythcott-Haims's (former dean of freshman and undergraduate advising at Stanford University) response to the question "What are the skills every 18-year-old needs?" was shared. Many colleges, including Stanford, offer a transition class to help freshmen successfully navigate college. Lythcott-Haims says, *Our ongoing challenge remains being relevant in the lives of undergraduates who may not want advice from anyone older than the upperclassman down the hall. It's our job to create credibility with them.*"

All our teachers acknowledged that if students entering a highly selective school like Stanford are in need of this support, then all our students could use help with these skills, and that we are on the right track with our freshman and sophomore leadership labs. With this in mind, we want to share with you how the work we are doing in the leadership labs aligns with the skills listed in Lythcott-Haims's response.

## Junior Counselor Corner

We have met with Juniors to discuss important college and transition information during academic lab. Please visit our website to view the PowerPoint, and send any questions you may have to Ms. Brown (cbrown4@parkwayschools.net) or Mrs. Wills (cwills@parkwayschools.net).

Please encourage your students to meet with either Ms. Wills or myself to continue planning for after high school. They have completed assessments and post-secondary institution searches and added those to Naviance as a filter for information. Ask them to share this information with you as you continue planning for your students' future.

#### A few reminders:

- Naviance login—(Parkway email address) and password (student number). ALL post-secondary documents are submitted through this portal.
- Credit checks—Am I on track for graduation? What do I have on my schedule for 2<sup>nd</sup> semester?
- Application deadlines—Create a plan which includes submission of required documents by priority deadlines
- ACT—If you plan to take it again, make sure to sign up by November 3 at [actstudent.org](http://actstudent.org) for the December 9 test date
- Letters of recommendation—If you plan to ask teachers to write letters, you need to make sure you make contact with them prior to the request
- Transcripts—Requests for transcripts will only be honored through Naviance. Please make sure to return your Transcript Release form (purple form).

#### Reminders from class presentation:

- **Grades and Credits**
  - \* You should be starting your junior year with at least **14 credits**. If you have less than 14 credits, we will develop a plan for helping you meet graduation requirements.
  - \* You may earn up to 3.5 credits per semester for a total of 7 credits at the end of each school year. By May 2018 you should have a total of **21 credits**, and will only need to earn 10 more to meet graduation requirements.
  - \* Remember, **EVERY** grade counts. Each semester, your GPA will be added into your rolling cumulative GPA. The better your grades are, the more opportunities you will have after graduation.
- **Organization**
  - \* Use your Planner or electronic device to organize your time and establish routines for each day. Routines help with finishing projects, remaining current in class and content and ensuring you have time for yourself.
  - \* Plan ahead & schedule time for your after-school activities and homework.
  - \* Schedule sufficient time to study and complete homework.
  - \* Don't forget to plan for enough time for rest, family and friends, too.
- **Self- Advocacy**
  - \* YOU are your number one advocate. Use your voice to ask questions, to verify information, clarify understanding.
  - \* Feel free to visit me as needed.
- **Get Involved**
  - \* Find a club, sport or extracurricular activity to get involved in. School can be much more than only earning credits towards graduation.
  - \* Take advantage of the A+ Program which incorporates district approved volunteer work, 95% attendance and minimum 2.5 grade point average

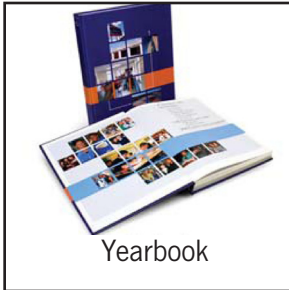

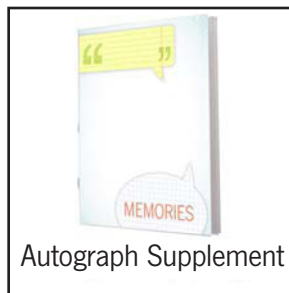

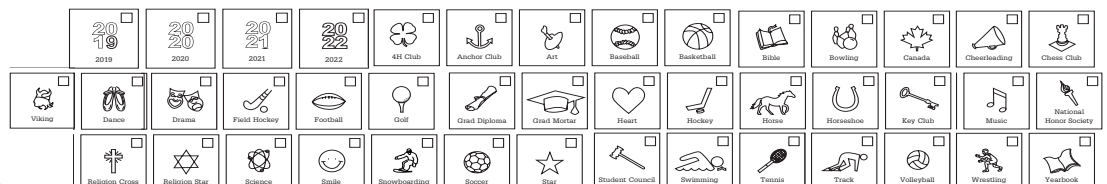
