Dear North High Families,

Last month the steel framework of the new music classrooms went up and this week the concrete floors were completed. These were two turning points in the construction of the new band, choir and orchestra rooms. These benchmarks are celebrated because we acknowledge that we have achieved a short-term goal in this much anticipated construction project. When a Gantt chart for a construction project is created, every item is included on the chart so that the contractors and others can see the dates that work is supposed to be happening in each area of the construction. A chart like this allows us to see how all parts of the construction project are interconnected, and allows us to mark the progress of the project along the way.

When I talk to students about setting SMART goals, a construction Gantt chart is a tool that can help them visualize their goal and the action steps they need to take to achieve their goals. They can see that if their goal for the semester is to get a B in a class, there has to be work done every day to accomplish that goal. They need to have mini-goals or benchmarks set for each six week marking period, and action steps to go along with each of those benchmarks. Students need to think about how they spend time on weekends and after school studying, completing homework and assignments, and getting help from peers and teachers. Students need to consider how they spend time in class and during ac lab, and ask themselves if they are actively participating and focused. Tracking student progress weekly is helpful to them so they can see adjustments that need to be made, so they can achieve their end goal--just like contractors do with a long-term construction project.

We begin the final six weeks of the semester this week. Now is the time for students to review their semester goals and determine what action steps need to be taken to achieve those goals. Making a clear plan for focused after school study time and for active participation in class will give students the best chance of reaching their goals. They need to see how the work they do in class and outside of class is interconnected, and to see that it is all important in achieving their goals.

Principal's Letter, cont.

One of my personal goals for this semester is to be intentional about expressing my gratitude to at least two people each week. Every day people do helpful things for me and for others; it is important to acknowledge these kind and caring acts. Now that I have set a specific goal for myself, I am committed to achieving that goal each week. Interestingly, because I am focused on expressing my gratitude, I find myself noticing more and more kind gestures people are doing.

Since it is November and the season of Thanksgiving, I encourage you to set a mini-goal to express your gratitude to others for the rest of the year. You will be pleased to notice how kind and helpful others are, and how good it makes you feel to express your thankfulness to others.

Dear Parents of Freshmen,

This is a reminder that there are many supports available to your student. Every freshman is participating in lessons to help them develop skills to be successful; they should also be visiting with teachers when they need help. Ask your student about their Academic Lab plans every B day! Most teachers have a website or Google classroom with homework assignments and class information. It is common to meet with individual teachers at agreed-upon times before or after school. Please don't be shy to ask for individual help! The curriculum learning center is open for study after school Monday—Thursday.

Is your student doing particularly well in a subject? That's great! Perhaps your student should be moved into the Honors section of the course at the start of 2nd semester. This depends on teacher recommendation and availability of seats, but please have your student talk about this with their current teacher.

Sophomores

Dear Sophomore Parents:

This month sophomores will attend a counseling presentation, which begins the exploration of planning for life after high school. Within this presentation they will complete a survey titled, "Do What You Are," an adaptation of the Myers-Briggs Type Indicator. This survey is frequently used for personality assessment and for career counseling. It shows tendencies of a person towards being Extraverted or Introverted, Intuitive or Sensing, Perceptive or Judging, Thinking or Feeling. From their results students can learn about job descriptions that match their particular tendencies.

These surveys should be completed within 25-40 minutes on each student's Naviance Family Connections account. The results and the opportunity to review careers, projected openings and wages are available until the student graduates! I encourage students to be career savvy! You can review your student's results as well: go to the Parkway North website > Counseling > Naviance. <u>Juniors</u>

Juniors were sent an invitation to sign up for live ACT prep classes held at North after school. Check your Parkway email account and follow the easy prompts to sign up. Classes are subject to seat and resource limits, so act quickly!

Credits

As juniors, it is important to pay attention to your credit situation. Juniors should currently have 14 credits, and will have 17.5 at the end of the semester. If you are credit deficient, please contact me and/or Dr. Cain to develop a plan to ensure you are on track for graduation.

Naviance

All juniors participated in Naviance training through their Academic Lab in the past month. The students learned how to search for colleges, sign up for a college visit, and how to sign on to "Testive," our test prep program for ACT. If you are a student who plans on attending a four-year college, now is the time to start searching and getting familiar with what you are looking for in a school. The College Corner Christy Wills, College, Career & Transition Counselor

Seniors—Very Important!

If you have an application due anytime between January I-15, you MUST complete your request and submit materials to the Guidance office no later than Friday, December 2 in order to assure that we have time to process it properly. When you are ready to send your application(s) to the college(s) of your choice, please follow these procedures:

- I. If you are applying to a Common Application school, please notify your recommenders. All Common App schools require transcripts, forms, and rec letters electronically. Please see Ms. Larsen or Ms. Wills with any Common App questions.
- 2. Complete the official Transcript Release Form!
- 3. Indicate any deadlines on your Naviance requests.
- 4. If you require a counselor recommendation, you must complete the Recommendation Survey (in detail) at least TEN school days prior to when you need your application sent or mailed.

Please note: It is **YOUR** responsibility to be aware of admission, financial aid, scholarship, housing, etc. deadlines for each college and university you are interested in attending. It is very important that students are filling out their own applications. While parents may assist in this process, students should take ownership of this process and do their own work.

Mid-year Reports: For students who have completed the Common Application, your mid-year reports will be sent automatically. For students using a university online portal, schools will send an email notifying your recommenders that a mid-year report is due. No notification is necessary on your part.

College Representatives: Seniors may sign up via their Naviance account to meet with college reps that visit North. The list of college visits is available on the landing page for each student's Naviance account. Sign-up is required no later than 2:00 the day prior to the visit.

ACT Prep Courses: North offers a free ACT prep course 4 times per year. The second round of courses begin November 14. To register, go to https://goo.gl/ZuhWQ0.

Online ACT Prep: Needing even more ACT prep? We are encouraging students to utilize a new, free online resource called Testive. You can find more info at http://schools.testive.com/parkway-north


