

## <u>Daily...</u>

- Snacks:
  - We have a morning snack and an afternoon snack. I have found that the kids like to eat more than one snack during these times. It may be helpful to pack several snacks.
- Lunch box:
  - Please put the snacks each day inside of the lunch box.
- Water bottle- Please send a fresh filled water bottle everyday to school. We will send it home with your child daily to be washed and refilled. Please make sure the water bottle is spill proof. Please make sure your child's name is on their water bottle!
- Full child size backpack- big enough for a lunch box and folder, not a mini backpack please

Mondays... or first day of the week please send your child's nap items

- Nap Items:
  - Crib sheet (this works best for putting over the cot but anything will work), blanket, pillow, a small stuffed animal
  - Large ziplock bag to keep items in- these can be found at Lowe's <u>or Amazon</u>

## <u>Clothes...</u>

• An extra set of clothes in a gallon ziplock bag. Shirt, pants or shorts, socks, underwear. With your child's name written on the bag.

## Supplies....

- 3 rolls of paper towels
- 1 box of kleenex
- 1 bath or hand sized towel- does not need to be new. It will be used to dry the playground, and clean messy art or large spills.

- Box of Gallon Zip Lock Bags
