1. Please rent or buy an instrument. **It is very important to obtain an instrument that is not too large for your child. Playing an instrument that is too large can produce excess stress on the body and hinder your child's interest and progress. It is better to play an instrument that is too small than too large.** Please attach a luggage tag with your student's name on the handle of the case for easy identification.
 2. One 2" three ring binder with pockets on the inside front and back cover.
 3. 25 **non glare, clear**, plastic 3-ring sheet protectors
 4. 1 zippered 3-ring pencil pouch to be placed in binder
 5. 3 highlighters of various colors
 6. 4 extra fine point Sharpies for 5th Grade
 7. 6 sharpened pencils
 8. 5th grade only Method Book: Orchestra Expressions Book 1 for your instrument
 9. Folding music stand for home practice.
 10. Shoulder rest or black loft sponge. Kun, Viva and Everest are all good shoulder rests. For a less expensive option you can order the loft sponge which is the black contoured foam shoulder rest from the Loft Violin Shop. They can be ordered on line at www.theloftviolinshop.com or purchased at the beginning of the school year. Make sure the shoulder rest or sponge matches the size of your instrument. **Please do not buy a memory foam sponge.**
