## **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

This course is for the advanced theatre student who is ready to demonstrate proficiency as a director. It is a laboratory course, which uses the theatrical production process as its experiment. Through the art of directing, acting, and design, students will apply these concepts to a final production, to be presented to the school and public. Successful completion of Actors' Studio I, II and Technical Theatre is required. Students must also commit to additional time after school for rehearsal, research or technical preparation. Students may have the option of taking this class for an Honors Grade.

## **REQUIREMENTS**

- 1. Enroll in an approved HONORS GRADE class.
- 2. Submit written reviews of 10 one act & 10 full length plays.
- 3. Prepare and lead a warm-up, relaxation, or group activity for a theatre class or group.
- 4. Participate in the CO-CURRICULAR program.
- 5. Submit a complete and insightful PROMPT BOOK, of superior quality, which includes additional required activities specific to Honor Grade applicants.
- 6. Design, produced & strike all TECHNICAL aspects of a 1-act.
- 7. Complete a visual representation of the set in addition to the floor plan.
- 8. Receive all OUTSTANDING RATINGS on major projects.
