Project: Radio Show

THE ASSIGNMENT

Working in groups of four, you will write and produce a radio play (drama, comedy, or satire) that is 5-8 minutes in length and produce it for the class, live.

THE SCRIPT

The play should involve four scenes (more if necessary) -- each group member will be responsible for writing and planning out one scene. If your storyline won't accommodate four scenes, then split one longer scene between two people. EVERYONE SHOULD PARTICIPATE IN THE PLANNING AND WRITING OF THE SCRIPT.

CHARACTERS

The members of your group will play all of the parts in your play--people can play more than one part if necessary. Remember......make your characters original and interesting. There is no action for the audience to look at.... only your voices to listen to.

SOUND EFFECTS

You are required to use music and a minimum of 5 different sound effects. BE CREATIVE!!! The purpose of sound effects and music is to make your play exciting for the listener.
