

PCH THEATRE PARENT SCHOLARSHIP

RULES

ELIGIBILITY

The applicant must be...

- 1. a graduating SENIOR or given special permission by the dramatic sponsor.**
- 2. a member of and in “good standing” with I.T.S., Troupe #1876 and the PCH Players while attending PCH.**

ESSAY

The essay must

- 1. be written in proper form with correct spelling, punctuation and grammar.**
- 2. have 1” margins and double spaced.**
- 3. have a font size of 12 and be Times Roman.**
- 4. have a length of approximately 3 pages.**
- 5. NOT include any detailed remarks that would identify yourself. (referring to a show you were in or worked on, is not the same as noting the specific role or job)**

DEADLINE

- 1. Essays are due to the dramatic sponsor by THE FIRST FRIDAY IN APRIL.**
- 2. Turn in 2 copies; one WITH your name and one WITHOUT.**

EVALUATION

- 1. A panel will judge the anonymous essays in order to obtain an impartial conclusion.**
- 2. The panel will include various members of the staff and faculty from PCH.**
- 3. Noncompliance with any of the guidelines WILL result in disqualification of your entry.**
- 4. The decisions of the judges are final and may not be appealed.**
- 5. Scholarship/s will be awarded at the Drama/I.T.S. Banquet in May.**
