### Course Objectives:

- Students taking Drawing 2 will learn:
- To use a variety of different drawing media including graphite, charcoal, conte, colored pencil, pastel & ink.
  - To accurately observe and depict 3-dimensional forms on a 2-dimensional surface.
  - To achieve a full range of lights and darks using charcoal, pencil and other media.
  - To arrange the elements of a drawing to create a successful composition.
  - To accurately measure proportions and translate them onto a drawing surface.

### Assignments & Projects: (tentative)

- Value Scale (pencil)
- 3 Object Still Life (charcoal)
- Landscape (pen and ink)
- Foreshortened object (colored pencil)
- Human or animal portrait (oil or soft pastel)
- Extreme close-up (pencil)
- Final exam (a one-day drawing)
- Sketchbook (extra credit)
