

READING INTERVENTION

Welcome to Parkway Central Middle School Reading Strategies. All the students have been given individual reading assessments and we have started the lessons. The program is Leveled Literacy Interventions created by Fountas and Pinnell. There is a maximum of five students in each class. This ensures every student receives individual attention. The program consists of intensive, small group lessons implemented every day, so class attendance and participation are crucial to student success.

We continue to read books from the Leveled Literacy Intervention program. Each class and section is reading a different book, and some sections are reading a class novel. These books are high interest, and students seem to enjoy reading and discussing the books. The students practice to build their vocabulary, phonics and comprehension skills by using Quizlet on a regular basis in class.

Students are expected to read a book of their choice every night for 30 minutes for homework.
