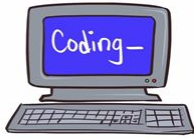


PRACTICAL ARTS



ENGINEERING AND TECHNOLOGY

Mr. Lanning's sixth grade class is starting a unit on Flight & Space in which they will research how aircraft are able to fly while learning Newton's basic laws of motion and Bernoulli's theories on propulsion. These ideas and principles will be applied by the students while they learn to fly using a flight simulator software.

Mr. Lanning's seventh grade classes will be exploring Energy & the Environment and how alternative energy sources can be used to reduce each person's carbon footprint and can help eliminate pollution.

Mr. Lanning's eighth grade class will be introduced to the basic principles of electricity and how atomic structure affects the characteristics of materials.

Mr. Hoermans eighth grade class is continuing to work on personal finance. Eighth grade just finished up working in Everfi, an online platform to help teach personal finance basics. They will move into one of my personal favorite games, stock market simulation on marketwatch.com. Students invest \$100,000 of fake money into the market and the simulation will show students if they would have had gains or losses based on what happens within the real stock market.
