This week in West Time students learned about **Habit 1-Be Proactive**. Being proactive means you are in charge of yourself- your thoughts, your actions, and your words. They practiced using proactive language. Responding in a proactive way is to stop and think before responding. Stopping and thinking before we respond helps us to consider our options before making a choice.

Ask your child:

- 1. How to use proactive language. Answer: I will, I can, I chose.
- 2. Do Proactive people blame others? Answer: no
- 3. What is the difference between reactive people and proactive people? Answer: Reactive people blame others. They let other be in charge of their attitude and thoughts.
