Ask your child about the 7 Habits of Highly Effective People? See how many they can name. This is the learning they worked on during West Time this week.

Next Wednesday will be a LEAD Time Schedule and students will meet with their LEAD Group for the second time. Students will begin to develop norms and determine the purpose of their group's time together. Our goals for this time together are:

- Students will work in an 80/20 structure where they will lead 80 percent of the work in the LEAD group to honor their voices.
- Students will develop a sense of purpose in the group because learning is student-driven and centered.
- Students are designing their own learning experience during this time with a common interest.
- Students will use an inquiry method to navigate the content, gather information, research and make sense of the important ideas.
- Students will create (make, publish, design, act or do) an end product.
- Students will lead their learning by working together, connect with their peers, communicating ideas, use critical thinking, creativity, and focusing on strengths during this time.
