7. Principal's Report - Dr. Adam Kealen

- a. 6th Grade Camp last week, 10/7-10/10; it was beautiful weather, and the kids had a great time.
- b. October 29: Megan Meier foundation is coming in to speak 2 sessions on cyber bullying (one 6th graders, one 7th/8th graders). Parent session is that evening. This event will be hosted at West Library for the entire district.
- c. Week of 10/21: Red Ribbon Week is next week
- d. Dr. Kealen just got back last week from the conference in Atlanta, GA on MTSS (multi-tiered system of support, i.e. intentional intervention). He's looking to implement lessons learned over the next few years. This will be a cost neutral system to implement; involves reworking existing systems. This is a mind shift for teachers to identify kids who don't understand essential ideas and catch them up with more focused instruction so everyone can proceed together.
