3. Treasurer Report – Sarah Masterson

- a. Still waiting on invoice for shirts from Fun Run
- b. Robyn Hayes donated cost of coffee truck, which had to be rescheduled due to flooding issues.
- c. Need to keep truck expense in the budget for future runs.
- d. An extension had to be filed this year for taxes since we brought in more money than what we can file using the EZ form; a fellow parent CPA is assisting with the tax returns.
- e. PTO would like to increase the budget for pre-purchased spirit wear inventory since we are at the top of the budget and we have additional selling opportunities for in-person sales.
- f. Budget Change Proposed:
 - i. PTO recommended increasing expense from \$10K to \$15, and income from \$15K to \$20.
 - ii. Tamara motioned to update the spirit wear budget line items; Casey Pfarr seconded the motion.
