### Criteria:

- **Student's first and last name need to be on every envelope**

- If small envelopes are sent inside a larger envelope, write the student's full name on all envelopes.
- Items should be flat.
- Do not send anything of value, (ex: cash, check, gift card) as we cannot be responsible for it.
- Packages cannot be accepted.
