

Pierremont Scrips Gift Card Program

In time for Holiday shopping and gift giving!

What is it?

Scrips are gift cards. When Pierremont families purchase gift cards, we are purchasing shopping cards which are the same as cash. The shopping cards look just like gift cards or gift certificates we would purchase at stores. The cards are issued by a national retailer. When we shop using gift cards, we raise funds for Pierremont simply by shopping for our family's groceries, everyday needs, special events, and gifts. Cards can buy the gift or be the gift!

Sounds great, but how does Pierremont make money?

The merchants offer gift cards for sale to non-profit organizations at a discount. If you purchase one gift card at \$25.00, you will receive a \$25.00 gift card for shopping. The PTO buys the cards at discounted rates and keeps the difference as profit.

How do I buy them?

1. Complete the Scrips Family Order form and return it to the front office (backpack mail) with your payment.
2. Make checks payable to Pierremont PTO.
3. Orders are due in the front office on the following dates by 8:30am

Cards Ready:

Friday, December 6
Wednesday, December 18
