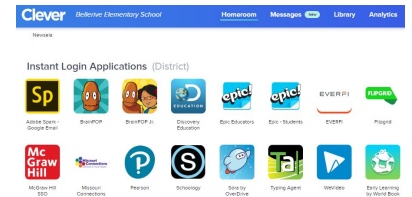
Schoology

Schoology will be used to engage students with their grade level information, learning activities, and assignments. Other technology tools will be utilized, but Schoology will be the hub for all instruction for students. Schoology provides consistency for parents and students so they have one place to go for all of their classes. Students will have a course labeled CLASSROOM that they will access daily. Parents are able to access Schoology to see what work their child has been assigned.



Clever

The Clever portal is where students can access their learning applications like Schoology, Pearson, BrainPop, Epic, and more, simply by using their Google login.



Video Conferencing

Zoom and Google Meet are the video conference tools that students will use. Students will use the code that is shared from their teacher to access the meetings for class lessons, small group work, individual conferences, specials, and more.

Helpful tips for students when video conferencing:

- Be on time
- Keep materials close
- Eliminate distractions
- Mute your microphone, unless it is your turn to speak
- Find a place with good internet and little background noise
