

COVID-19 Antibody Testing

CareATC is using a COVID-19 antibody test authorized for use by the FDA that may help identify previous COVID-19 infections.

Please schedule an appointment with your CareATC provider to determine if antibody testing is appropriate.

Please note: walk-ins are not allowed for antibody testing.

Who Should Get an Antibody Test?

- Healthcare workers and individuals with high-risk exposure to known COVID-19 patients. Testing should be performed at least 14 days after exposure to an infected patient
- Patients who have had high-risk exposure >14 days before and do not currently have symptoms.
- Patients who were previously symptomatic consistent with COVID-19 (previously tested or not)
- · Patients who:
 - are in high-risk situations
 - are critical to infrastructure
 - are working with the general public
 - for other reasons need to know immunity status
- Patients deemed appropriate for testing by a provider
