Communicating with Mason Ridge

- **Communicating with Teachers:** “Early and often” in an essential part of caring for your child’s education. Teachers can alert you to any social/emotional or academic challenges at school. Notify teachers of changes that might impact your child’s behavior at school.
- **Parent Teacher Conferences:** Parent teacher conferences are held twice a year on October 2nd & 3rd and on March 3rd & 5th. The school will send out a sign-up link so parents may select a date and time to meet with their student(s) teachers during parent/teacher conferences. Conferences are for adults only unless your teacher tells you otherwise.
- **School Hours:** 9:05 am – 4:00 pm. Morning drop off begins at 8:45 am. There is no supervision for children prior to 8:45 am or after 4:10 pm.
- **Adventure Club:** Before and after school care. For more information contact Adventure Club at adventureclub@prcommunityed.org.
- **Changes in Dismissal:** Contact the main office and the classroom teacher. Dismissal change slips are included in this folder for you to send to school with your child if you prefer to use those.
- **Attendance Line:** Call 314-415-6476 if your child is sick and/or expected to be out of school for the day.
- **Late Start Wednesdays:** On the last in session Wednesday of each month, school and busses start two hours later. Start time is 11:05 am. Drop off begins at 10:45 am.

PTO Fundraising at Mason Ridge

Mighty Mustang Fund: Mason Ridge's "no-hassle" fundraising campaign that is a key source of income for the PTO annually. The PTO does not ask our students to sell items to raise money for our school community. Instead, we ask that all parents who are able make a one-time donation. 100% of the donations benefit Mason Ridge Elementary. Donations of any size can be made to the Mighty Mustang Fund and all donations are greatly appreciated. Please see the Mighty Mustang Fund insert for more information.

Corporate Matching: Many companies offer a matching donation program for dollars or hours you donate to 501 (c)(3) non-for-profit organizations. Please submit this paperwork through your company! For reference when completing your company's paperwork, the Mason Ridge PTO federal tax ID is 43-1151106.

Spirit Nights: For each Spirit Night held throughout the year, a designated local business will donate a portion of the proceeds from Mason Ridge families to the Mason Ridge PTO. Look for monthly events in the Sunday Newsletter and join the Mason Ridge community for a night out.

Box Tops: Earn cash for Mason Ridge by clipping Box Tops from hundreds of products you buy at the grocery store from cereals to sandwich bags. Each Box Top is valued at 10¢. Clip and collect these in plastic bags of 25 or 50, indicating how many you have in each bag, and drop them off near the front entrance. We submit Box Tops twice a year on Nov. 1 and Mar 1.

Amazon Smile: If you shop at Amazon, please consider using Amazon Smile at smile.amazon.com instead. Amazon donates a small percentage of your purchase value when purchases are made on Amazon Smile to a designated charity. Please designate Mason Ridge PTO as your charity on Amazon Smile to direct donations to Mason Ridge PTO.

eScrip: If you shop at Schnucks, earn donations from them via the eScrip program. Please designate Mason Ridge PTO to direct donations to us. Use your eScrip card at checkout and your purchases will automatically generate contributions of up to 3% of your purchase price for Mason Ridge PTO.

Trivia Night: Saturday, March 7th A fun casual adult only night out to socialize with friends featuring silent and live auctions.



Volunteer Application

In an effort to keep our students safe, adults who volunteer for activities that require supervision of students without Mason Ridge staff present need to complete a background check. Examples of this could include reading with students outside of the classroom or chaperoning a small group on a field trip.

The Parkway School District volunteer application is located on the Mason Ridge website under the Parents tab. This application must be completed annually.

The Mighty Mustang Fund FAQ

Why we fundraise at a public school and what does the money go towards?

Mason Ridge Parent Teacher Organization (PTO) has a long standing tradition of providing a wide variety of programs that benefit the teachers, students, and families at Mason Ridge. Our budget averages approximately \$50,000 in expense annually and is funded through donations. Some of the programs funded by the Mason Ridge PTO include the ACE Program (Arts & Cultural Enrichment), Teacher Appreciation, Science Night, and School Celebrations. Other larger expenses we have helped support in the past include Classroom Smartboards, Educational Software, Kindergarten Playground Equipment, Laptops, Teacher Continuing Educations, Green Water Fountains, Cameras and Projectors.

What is the Mighty Mustang Fund & why do we use this format at Mason Ridge?

The Mighty Mustang Fund is a fundraising effort in the form of direct donations, in many cases matched by employers. In the past, we have held fundraising programs where the children were asked to sell items and only a portion of the proceeds were kept by the school. We have found that by using the Mighty Mustang Fund, Mason Ridge PTO is able to use 100% of the proceeds toward the school. Additionally, using this format has achieved greater donations as companies are able to match donations made by their employees!

Will this be the only time I am asked to donate to the school?

No. There are many small fundraising activities that happen throughout the year, including Spirit Nights, Book Fair, etc. We also hold an adult only trivia night in the spring that includes a silent and live auction.

How can I pay?

You may return the attached form with cash or check payment made out to Mason Ridge PTO to the school office. Or you can pay by credit card through the PayPal Giving Fund directly to Mason Ridge PTO by going to <https://www.paypal.com/us/fundraiser/charity/2086741>

Mason Ridge PTO will provide a donation letter for all donations made. The PayPal Giving Fund will also provide a donation letter for donations made online via the PayPal Giving Fund.

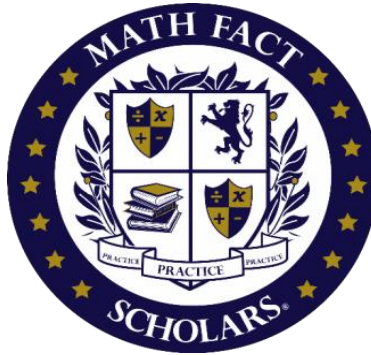
Membership Toolkit is separate from Parkway's Infinite Campus so **we rely on you to add your family!** You're in control of what information you want visible in the directory. The on-line directory is the go-to resource for families to contact each other for events, play dates, birthday party invites, etc. You can purchase Math Fact Scholars items, sign-up to volunteer, and much more. Get started today and stay in the loop with your Mason Ridge community!

Here's what you need to do:

- **Go to <http://masonridge.membershiptoolkit.com/>**
- Choose "Login / Create Account" and **Create Account**.
- Once you have created your account and verified your email address, then log in to add your family information and finish the registration process.
- If you had a MySchoolAnywhere account, then your information has been migrated to our new directory, but you still need to create a new login. After creating your account, you'll be asked to review your information from last year.
- After you've setup your user account, be sure to **download the Mobile App** for convenient access from your mobile device. This is a really handy tool!
- The Primary User can "**invite**" **other email addresses** to access his/her account. This allows the Secondary User to have their own login information, but still have access to the family account. Go to "My Account – Settings - Access" to do this.

Returning families can continue to access MySchoolAnywhere during the transition. MySchoolAnywhere will no longer be available after 9/30/19.

MATH FACT SCHOLARS is a weekly math testing program that motivates Kindergarten – 5th students to improve their math skills as they advance through program skill levels, mastering basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, & division facts, multi-digit computation, and working with fractions, decimals and percentages. Students earn ribbons, medals and trophies along the way! This program is an independent program not associated with the Parkway School District.

1. The program has two components: (a) take-home workbooks to be completed at a student's own pace; and, (b) weekly testing. Students progress to the next level when the workbooks are completed and the final test for that level is passed.
2. Workbooks can be purchased through Membership Toolkit at <https://masonridge.membershiptoolkit.com/form/m/85646> for \$25.00 (ribbon/medal) or \$35.00 (trophy level). Please contact Sona Patel if there are any issues purchasing books or if you do not receive the books within a week of purchase.
3. Testing is every Wednesday, 8:15 to 8:50 a.m. (and Fridays on late start weeks). Testing for Grades 1 through 5 will begin September 4, 2019; testing for kindergarten students begins on October 2, 2019. Test dates should appear on the weekly calendar emailed to parents or on the School's website. Testing is in the Ramsey Center (ribbon and medal level) and Art room (trophy level) at Mason Ridge. Students will receive a sheet of paper indicating their next test level every week. Students can begin testing at any time after the respective start dates. If students cannot make it to each test session, no problem! They start where they left off at a subsequent session.
