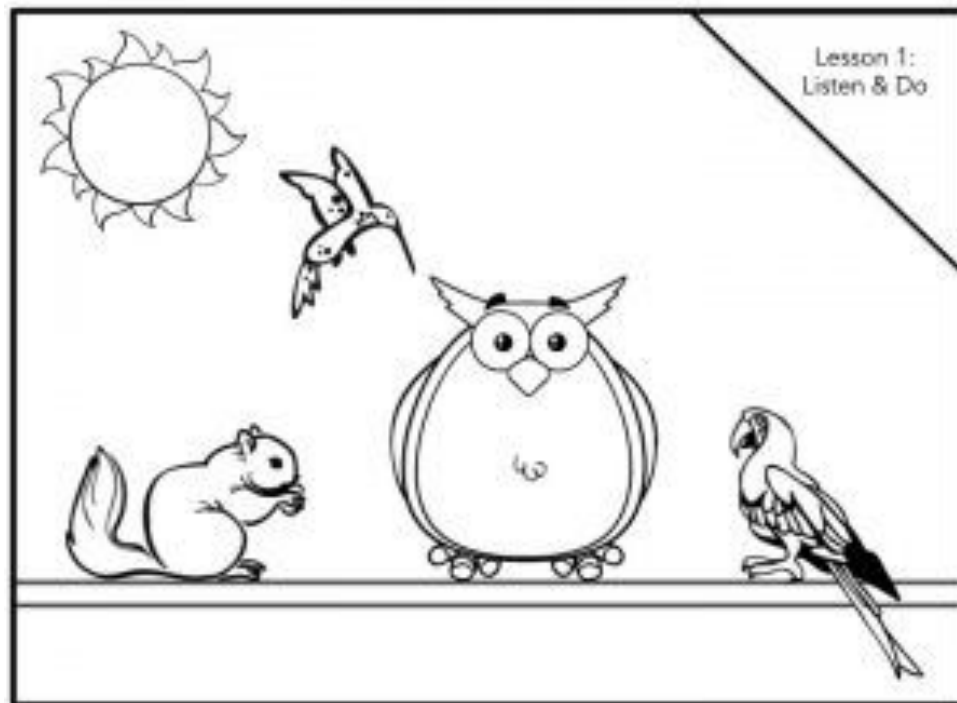


We are excited this year to provide activities for our students to support our **Seven Habits of Happy Kids** at home! This activity is a fun LISTENING activity you can do with your family at home!

Habit 5 says we **seek first to understand and then to be understood** - LISTEN first and then speak/act. This is a challenging skill for many kiddos (and some adults, too!). Hopefully you have fun practicing this habit at home!

To play, have one family member read the step by step directions while another family member tries to complete the tasks. You may want to cut the directions from this form and hold them as you read. See who can follow all the directions correctly! Want a challenge? You could also try to create your own similar listening riddles together.



Color the owl's stomach brown and then his talons (claws) yellow.

Draw two clouds in the sky and then color them grey.

Color every part of the hummingbird blue and then circle it.

Write your first name under the telephone line and then underline it.

Draw a mouse on the telephone line and then color it brown.

Color every part of the parrot red and then draw blue stripes on its tail.

Color every part of the squirrel grey and then draw a black hat on top of its head.

Color the sun yellow.
