MATH FACT SCHOLARS is a weekly math testing program that motivates Kindergarten – 5th students to improve their math skills as they advance through program skill levels, mastering basic addition, subtraction, multiplication, & division facts, multi-digit computation, and working with fractions, decimals and percentages. Students earn ribbons, medals and trophies along the way! This is not a math tutoring program. Working at their own pace, students advance in the program based upon their efforts to prepare for the weekly testing sessions and complete the testing requirements for each skill level. Students receive program workbooks for at-home math skill practice.

Registration fees are paid, per skill level, as the child advances in the program.

Payment for all levels at one time *cannot* be accepted.

Blue Ribbon/Medal Levels = \$25 each. Trophy Levels = \$35 each.

Weekly MATH FACT SCHOLARS testing sessions take place at Barretts Elementary School every Friday from 8:20 a.m. to 8:55 a.m. from September 6, 2019 – May 8, 2020. Testing location: Room #404 Start anytime during the school year. Registration fees are per level, not per school year. Students arriving on the bus have time to test their math skills, too! Parent volunteers are needed to implement this weekly math enrichment program. See volunteer sign up below.

Skill Level Registration Fee: Check one skill level. Please note grade level and pre-requisite requirements. MATH FACT SCHOLARS skill level workbooks must be completed prior to advancing to the next level in the program.

- ___ **Blue Ribbon Level:** \$25 skill level registration fee includes addition & subtraction practice workbooks.
K-1st Grade Required. Skills tested: addition & subtraction facts. Weekly testing for Kindergarten students begins January 10, 2020.
- ___ **Bronze Medal Level:** \$25 skill level registration fee includes addition & subtraction practice workbooks.
K- 3rd Grade Required. Pre-requisite for K & 1st grade: Blue Ribbon. Skills tested: addition & subtraction facts.
- ___ **Silver Medal Level:** \$25 skill level registration fee includes multiplication & division practice workbooks.
4th Grade Required. Pre-requisite for K-3rd grade: Bronze Medal. Skills tested: multiplication & division facts.
- ___ **Gold Medal Level:** \$25 skill level registration fee includes multiplication & division practice workbooks.
5th Grade Required. Pre-requisite: K-4th grade: Silver Medal. Skills tested: multiplication & division facts (Advanced).
- ___ **Platinum Trophy Level:** \$35 skill level registration fee includes Platinum level practice workbook. Pre-requisite: Gold Medal.
Skills tested: multi-digit addition, subtraction, multiplication & long division.
- ___ **Olympian Series-Fractions Trophy Level:** \$35 skill level registration fee includes Fractions level practice workbook.
Pre-requisite: Platinum Trophy. Skills tested: adding, subtracting, multiplying & dividing fractions, and more.
- ___ **Olympian Series-Decimals Trophy Level:** \$35 skill level registration fee includes Decimal level practice workbook.
Pre-requisite: Olympian Series-Fractions Trophy. Skills tested: adding, subtracting, multiplying & dividing decimals, and more.
- ___ **Olympian Series-Percents Trophy Level:** \$35 skill level registration fee includes Percent level practice workbook.
Pre-requisite: Olympian Series-Decimals Trophy. Skills tested: computing discounts, sales tax, gratuity, conversion of fractions, decimals & percentages, and more.
