Nutritional Analysis of Menus

- The Nutritional Analysis of all of our menus are posted on the Nutrition Services website.
- Serving sizes, carbohydrates, protein, fat content, calories, vitamins and minerals are listed.

Breakfast/Lunch Menu Plan

For a meal to be reimbursable or subsidized, we are required to follow the USDA meal plans:

Breakfast: 5 component maximum or 3 component minimum (one being the serving of a fruit or vegetable). When two of the same side dish are chosen or more than 5 items are taken, you will be charged extra.

Menu Items Offered:

Grains: Cereal, Cereal Bars, Bagels, Muffins and Whole Grain Snack Cookies Fruits: 4 oz. Juice, Fresh Fruit, Fruit Cup and Dried Fruit Vegetable: Celery, Carrots Protein: Breakfast Wrap, Breakfast Sandwich and Yogurt Milk: 1% Milk, Skim and 1% Flavored Milk

Lunch: 5 component maximum or 3 component minimum (one being the serving of a fruit or vegetable). When two of the same side dish are chosen or more than 5 items are taken, you will be charged extra.

Whole Grains: Sandwich Bun, Hot Roll, Crackers, Bread Stick
Fruits: 4 oz. Juice, Fresh Fruit, Fruit Cup, Frozen Fruit, Dried Fruit and Cobblers
Vegetables: Cooked, Fresh, Beans or Salads
Protein: Chicken Fillets, Nuggets, Beef
Entrees, Roasted Pork, Baked Fish Pieces, Cheese, Pizza
Milk: 1% Milk, Skim and 1% Flavored Milk

Deposits

To make a deposit into your student's account, there are two options:

OPTION 1: Cash or Check to School

Payments sent to the school with your student may be dropped into a deposit box in the school. Please make sure the envelope has student's name and PIN number.

We will no longer accept payment at the register.

To set purchase limits please contact the school café directly.



OPTION 2: MySchoolBucks Sign up at www.MySchoolBucks.com

- Make a deposit using a debit card or credit card.
- Be notified of low balances by email, sign up for automatic deposits and view transaction histories.
- Make deposits to multiple schools for a single \$2.49 service fee from provider for each debit card or credit card session or if you deposit more frequently, use the One Pay Plan and pay \$12.95/yr. for Student Plan or Family Plan \$26.95/yr. – see district website for more information.

Point of Sale (POS) System

Nutrition Services uses a computerized POS payment system for the purchase of school meals.

- Students are assigned a personal identification number called a PIN.
- Once the PIN is assigned, your child can access his or her account.
- A cafeteria staff member or teacher will help your student with using the PIN.
- Meals or a la carte items purchased will be deducted from the account.

District Charge Policy

Unless meals are provided at no charge, the district expects students and employees to pay for meals prior to or at time of receipt. The ability to charge is a privilege, not a right, and is subject to the limitations established in administrative procedures.

- 1. Students may not accumulate more than 3 unpaid charges for complete meals.
- 2. A student who has accumulated 3 unpaid charges for complete meals and is still unable to pay for meals will be provided a substitute meal that meets the district's nutrition guidelines.
- 3. Substitute meals provided to the student will not be charged to the student's meal account.
- 4. Students may not charge Ala Carte items.
- 5. A student with money in hand, will not be denied a complete meal even if the student has past due charges.
- 6. Students will not be singled out, shamed, or punished by the District for the failure of their parents/guardians to pay for or provided meals, and the district will not hold student records in violation of the law.
