Point of Sale (POS) System

Nutrition Services uses computerized POS payment system for the purchase of school meals.

- Students are assigned a personal identification number called a PIN.
- Once the PIN is assigned, your child can access his or her account.
- A cafeteria staff member or teacher will help your student with using the PIN.
- Meals or a la carte items purchased will be deducted from the account.

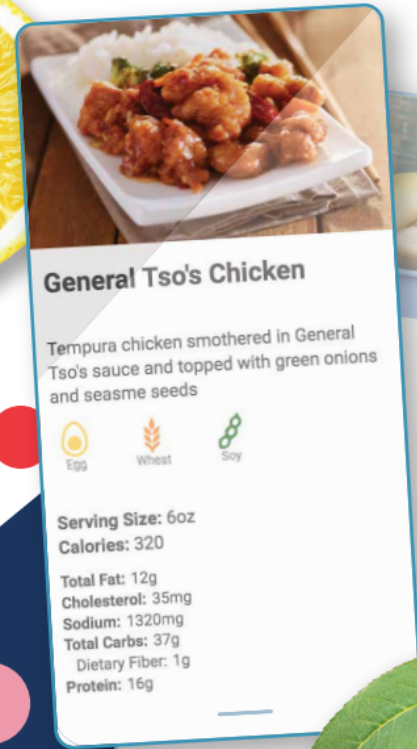

District Charge Policy

Unless meals are provided at no charge, the district expects students and employees to pay for meals prior to or at time of receipt. The ability to charge is a privilege, not a right, and is subject to the limitations established in administrative procedures.

1. Students may not accumulate more than 3 unpaid charges for complete meals.
2. A student who has accumulated 3 unpaid charges for complete meals and is still unable to pay for meals will be provided a substitute meal that meets the USDA guidelines.
3. Substitute meals provided to the student will not be charged to the student's meal account.
4. Students may not charge Ala Carte items.
5. A student with money in hand, will not be denied a complete meal even if the student has past due charges.
6. Students will not be singled out, shamed, or punished by the District for the failure of their parents/guardians to pay for or provided meals, and the district will not hold student records in violation of the law.

Deposits

To make a deposit into your student's account, there are two options:

Option 1: Cash or Check to School

Payments sent to the school with your student may be dropped into a deposit box in the school. Please make sure the envelope has the student's name and PIN number.

We no longer accept payment at the register.

To set purchase limits, please contact the school cafe directly.

Option 2: MySchoolBucks

- Make a deposit using a debit card or credit card.
- Be notified of low balances by email, sign up for automatic deposits and view transaction histories.
- Make deposits to multiple schools for single \$2.75 service fee from provider for each debit card or credit card session or if you deposit more frequently, use the One Pay Plan and pay \$12.95/yr for Student Pay Plan or Family Plan \$26.95/yr - see district website for more information.
