Summa Cum Laude: cumulative grade point average of 4.0 and above

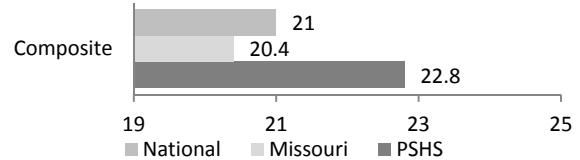

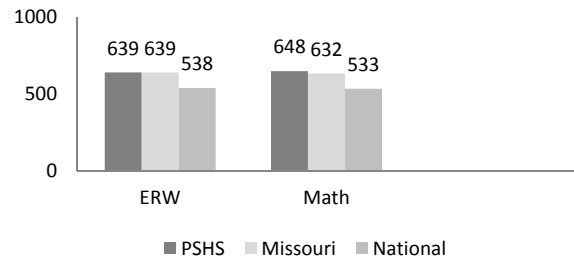
STANDARDIZED TESTING DATA
