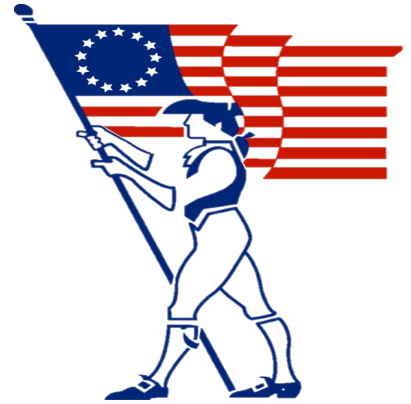

# Advanced Placement

---

AP Program & College Credit Opportunity 2019-20

# What is AP?

AP is the abbreviation for  
Advanced Placement

Program through the College Board (SAT, PSAT, & AP) offering college credit opportunities for students.

Teachers must be vetted through the College Board with an approved syllabus to be part of the AP program/course.

AP is trademarked, so only classes approved by the College Board can be named with AP in the class title.

# How is AP different from dual credit classes?

In May, there is an AP exam for each AP subject/class. It is a set national schedule. There is a fee for the exam.

AP credit is widely accepted overall. Typically highly selective colleges take AP over dual credit. Each college determines if and how they award credit.

Families should always do their research about college credit.

---

# How do you earn college credit through AP exams?

AP exams are scored between 1-5.  
Few colleges accept a 1 or 2.

Colleges determine the score they accept. College credit may be granted, or students may be allowed to move to the course, bypassing the course the AP exam represents.

Each college determines if they restrict how much college credit is allowed and which AP classes they will accept.

# Process for the AP program

---

Students create a College Board account or use their existing College Board account

These accounts need to be the student's responsibility and for their use

Parents are welcome to create a parent account for resources

Students "join" the specific class they are enrolled in with code for that AP class

Teachers may choose to make assignments through the College Board AP class

Students determine and communicate their decision on taking the exam by the deadline by using their College Board account

Students pay by cash or check in the book store the \$100 fee per exam

# Resources for Class Progress & Exam Prep

---

Taking the class is the best preparation for an AP exam

Teachers can choose to supplement the classroom material with the resources AP provides to be used through the College Board/AP class account

Teachers will determine if the online assignments enhance their regular teaching of the AP class. Assignments are through the student's College Board account

Khan Academy has an agreement with the College Board providing support for some AP classes



# Researching College Credit

---

Very important to have all the information to make informed decisions

Dual Credit - use College Website. Search “transfer dual credit” to gain information

AP Credit - the College Board account makes it easy to search and gain answers

NOTE - there are colleges that give different credit for dual credit and AP for the same high school class, so check both programs

NOTE - some colleges give more credit for 4 or 5 score than they do for a score of 3

# Late Testing

When is that an option?

If a student has 2 AP exams scheduled for the same day/time, one can be moved to late testing without additional charge.

If a student is ill the day of an AP exam, late testing without additional charge is an option.

Most other requests would have an additional \$40 late fee charge per College Board.

---

# Accommodation Testing

---

If a student has an IEP, Section 504 or official medical plan that has been in place four or more school months, a request for accommodations can be made.

Communication will be made within the next month to students in these categories to offer accommodation request filing.

Accommodation eligibility is determined by the College Board, not South High.

The application to request accommodations is completed by the high school.

This is a separate process from ACT. College Board & ACT are separate companies.
