

HIGH SCHOOL DIPLOMA REQUIREMENTS

- English ⇒ 4 Credits
- Math ⇒ 3 Credits
- Science ⇒ 3 Credits (must include Bio 1 and 2, Chem/Matter, Forces/Motion)
- Social Studies ⇒ 3 Credits (must include US History, World History and Gov't)
- **PE** → 1 Credit (must include PE Concepts)
- Career and Tech Ed → 1 Credit (Business, Tech, FACS, Journalism)
- **Fine Art** ⇒ 1 Credit (Art, Music, Theater)
- **Health** ⇒ ½ Credit
- Personal Finance → ½ Credit
- **Electives** ⇒ 7 Credits



GENERAL COLLEGE ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- English 4 Credits
- Math 4 Credits
- Science **3-4 Credits**
- Social Studies 3-4 Credits
- World Languages 2 4 Credits

In addition, highly selective colleges recommend <u>strong rigor</u> throughout high school! <u>What is rigor anyway?</u>





EXAMPLES OF RIGOR

Advanced Placement (AP) and Honors courses, as well as taking core courses all four years.

AP classes are high school courses that students can earn college credit.

Honors classes are courses that are designed to be more academically challenging.

Talk to your counselor if you are interested in taking advantage of **AP and Honors courses!**

HOW DO I EARN CREDIT?

- Every class = .5 (½) credit each semester.(No, you do not get credit for aclab)
- ☐ 7 classes each **semester** = 3.5 credits
- 2 semesters every year = 7 credits
- 4 years of High School= 28 credits (24 needed for graduation)
- Students are able to earn up to 1.0 credit in summer school each summer.



GET INVOLVED! STAY ELIGIBLE TO PARTICIPATE!

- We know students that get involved do better in school.
- Find something you like to do outside of class! South offers a lot of sports, performing groups and clubs for you to choose from.

ELIGIBILITY RULES

Athletics, Music Performance Groups and Speech/Debate are governed under the Missouri State High School Activities Association.

Students MUST meet eligibility requirements to participate!

In order to be eligible to participate in **MSHAA** activities students must receive **3.0 credits** the semester before the activity occurs.

TRANSCRIPTS

Your transcript is a record of:

- Courses you have taken
- Grades for every course
- **GPA** grade point average for each semester and your cumulative grade point average
- Credits each semester class is worth .5 credit

TIPS FOR SUCCESS

- Use <u>Academic Lab</u> during Mod 1, Mod 2, Mod 3
- <u>Homework Room</u> Tuesdays/Thursdays until 3:30 in library with Mr. Taylor (peer tutors may be available). No sign-up required
- Frequently check your <u>Infinite Campus Account</u> and your <u>SCHOOL EMAIL</u> (do you know how?)
- <u>School website</u> and teacher web pages
- Link Crew Leaders are here for you
- **Get involved** in sports, clubs and activities
- Learn healthy coping strategies to deal with stress
- Get to know your **counselor**, we are here to help!
