BUDGET OVERVIEW

- All money raised during the current school year funds the next school year's budget.
- The goal each year is to raise \$30,000 to fund all current activities for the next school year.
- In prior years, certain funding activities (i.e. direct donations, dine out nights, spirit wear sales) supported the operating budget while others supported the special projects budget (i.e. Trivia Night, Family Night). Starting this year, all funding sources go towards supporting the operating budget and any remaining funds are available for current or future special projects.

FUNDING SOURCES

- During the 2023-2024 school year, the Claymont community raised \$44,000.
- The majority of funding came from the Shorthorn Spirit Campaign and Trivia Night (80%)
