To qualify for a Freeman/Nance Scholarship, applicants must submit the following:

- 1. A copy of your most current transcript.(Does not have to be the official transcript)
- 2. A brief written statement describing your interest, motivation and determination to pursue education and/or training beyond high school, including instances where you demonstrated leadership abilities. (Please use a separate piece of paper and limit responses to approximately 100 words.)
- 3. Supply ACT/SAT scores plus high school class rank.
- 4. At least two (2) letters of recommendations from a school official or community organization or leader. (Letters from a family member will not be considered.)
- 5. A grade point average of 2.0 or better is required.

APPLICATIONS MUST BE TYPED OR PRINTED LEGIBLY IN BLACK OR BLUE INK.

It is important that the application packet be returned as soon as possible. Application packets must be postmarked by January 31^{st.}

APPLICATIONS RECEIVED WITH A POSTMARK AFTER January 31st WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.

Students who submit a complete application packet will be eligible to compete for a Freeman/Nance Scholarship. To remain in competition a student must participate in an interview. The date for the interviews will be announced through your email so make sure your email address is legible and clear.
