PARKWAY SCHOOL DISTRICT & COMMUNITY

The Parkway School District is in a suburban residential community located approximately 20 miles west of St. Louis in St. Louis County. It is the eighth largest district in the state and has 4 high schools. The district draws an ethnically diverse population from its neighborhoods and a voluntary inter district transfer program with St. Louis city schools. The mission of the Parkway School District is to ensure all students are capable, curious, confident and caring learners who understand and respond to the challenges of an ever-changing world.

PARKWAY NORTH HIGH SCHOOL

Parkway North High School is a public four-year comprehensive high school; grades 9, 10, 11 and 12.

Calendar & Schedule: The school year, which is divided into two semesters, has 178 days. Utilizing a block-scheduling format, each course meets twice a week for 90 minutes and once a week for 50 minutes. Students have the opportunity to take seven courses per semester. **For the 2020-2021 school year we are shifting to a quarter system, with students taking four classes Q1 and Q3 and three classes Q2 and Q4.**

Summa Cum Laude: cumulative grade point average of 4.0 and above

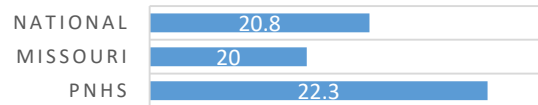
Magna Cum Laude: cumulative grade point average of 3.75-3.99
