PARKWAY SCHOOL DISTRICT & COMMUNITY

The Parkway School District is in a suburban residential community located approximately 20 miles west of St. Louis in St. Louis County. It is the tenth largest district in the state and has 4 traditional high schools and a virtual campus. The district draws an ethnically diverse population from its neighborhoods and a voluntary transfer program with St. Louis city schools. The mission of the Parkway School District is to ensure all students are capable, curious, confident and caring learners who understand and respond to the challenges of an ever-changing world.

PARKWAY NORTH HIGH SCHOOL

Parkway North High School is a public four-year comprehensive high school; grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. We have four comprehensive counselors with a caseload average 257 and 1 college and career counselor for the building.

Enrollment: 1028

Calendar & Schedule: The 178 day calendar is broken into 2 semesters. Utilizing a block-scheduling format, each course meets twice a week for 90 minutes and once a week for 50 minutes. Students have the opportunity to take seven courses per semester. For the 2020-2021 school year only we shifted to quarters, with students taking 4 classes in T1/T3 and 3 classes in T2/T4. T1-T2 were virtual. Students had the option to remain virtual the entire school year.
