The Parkway School District is in a suburban residential community located approximately 20 miles west of St. Louis in St. Louis County. It is the tenth largest district in the state and has 4 traditional high schools. The district draws an ethnically diverse population from its neighborhoods and a voluntary transfer program with St. Louis city schools. Parkway North High School is a public four-year comprehensive high school; grades 9, 10, 11 and 12. We have four comprehensive counselors with a caseload average 257 and 1 college and career counselor for the building.
