Assessment

The ongoing process of detailing

- 1. Community needs
- 2. Community dynamics
- 3. Community response capacity

Using quantitative and qualitative data.





Assessment: Profiling

- 1. Needs
 - a. Incidence rates
 - b. Root causes (causal factors or I.V.s)
- 2. Community Dynamics Demographics
 - a. History
 - b. Cohesion
 - c. Priorities
 - d. Readiness





Assessment: Profiling

- 3. Response Capacity
 - a. Resources
 - i. Social capital: community networks, partnerships, and key influencers
 - ii. Knowledge and skills
 - iii. Tools and equipment



Capacity

1. Building and Mobilizing Necessary Resources

- a. Funding: \$\$ and in-kind
- b. Recruitment
 - i. Social capital: community networks, partnerships, and key influencers
 - ii. Knowledge, skills and in-kind

2. Develop Knowledge and Skills About

- a. Identified community challenges
- Best practices for effecting community level change



Capacity (cont.)

- 3. Supplies and Equipment
 - a. Community volunteers
 - b. Space
 - c. Communications access
