Household Risk Management: Dealing with Alcohol, Medications and Other Risk Factors PTN Steve Morrison, Ballwin Police Department

Household management provides an important set of opportunities for substance abuse and suicide risk reduction, both with regard to home and community safety. Specifically, local and national data demonstrate that reducing access to alcohol, medications and firearms contributes significantly to reductions in rates of underage drinking, drug abuse and suicide. Patrolman Steve Morrison of the Ballwin Police Department will discuss important actions parents and community members can take to identify and reduce household risk factors, better assuring the safety of their homes and neighborhoods.
