3:45 Assisting Recovering Teens in Reengaging With Life Theresa Henry, MSOT, OTR/L

That area youth receive the treatment they need for mental health and/or substance abuse disorders is a critical aspect of improving community health. However, teens reintegration into the schools, homes and communities can be a complicated and fragile process, prone to despair, confusion and relapse. Ms. Henry is an occupational therapist working in the Washington University Community Practice Department, a member of AHC's executive board and a Parkway parent. In the past year, she has been instrumental in the development of a new program for youth returning to their schools and lives after extended treatment involvement. Ms. Henry's presentation will review the program design while highlighting the critical needs of this "high risk" population.
