I wish to participate in Parkway School District's A+ Schools Program. **If state funds are available**, I will receive reimbursement for the college expenses determined by legislative approval and appropriation of funds each year. This is on the condition that I meet the following requirements:

- 1) Attend an A+ high school for three years immediately prior to graduation (10<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grade).
- 2) Earn an accumulative high school grade point average of a 2.5 grade point or higher on a 4.0 scale (non-weighted).
- 3) Maintain a 95% high school attendance record for the 4 year period (attendance is not rounded up).
- 4) Perform 50 documented hours of unpaid tutoring or community service through a non-profit organization:
  - a. 25 hours MUST BE tutoring
  - b. 12.5 hours may be job shadowing
- 5) Maintain a record of good citizenship and avoid the unlawful use of drugs and/or alcohol.
- 6) Make a documented good faith effort to secure federal post-secondary student financial assistance funds during the last semester of the senior year so as to obtain the A+ financial incentive (FAFSA).
- 7) Register for Selective Service, if applicable (as required by law).
- 8) Achieve score of proficient or advanced on the official Algebra I end of course exam **or** a higher level DESE approved end-of-course exam in the field of mathematics.
- 9) Be a US Citizen or Permanent Resident (verification takes place at post-secondary institutions).
- 10) To retain this eligibility after high school graduation, I understand that I must enroll and attend on a full-time basis a Missouri public community college or public career/technical school, AND maintain a grade point average of 2.5 or higher on a 4.0 scale.

**CITIZENSHIP:** Students participating in the A+ Schools Program must maintain a record of "good citizenship" to qualify for postsecondary financial assistance. Good citizenship is demonstrated by respect for school, community, and self. Any student who participates in the A+ Schools Program must be a creditable citizen and be judged so by the proper school authority certifying the list of students for participation. A student whose character or conduct reflects credit upon themselves and/or their school is considered a creditable citizen and is therefore eligible to participate in the A+ Schools Program. Their conduct shall be satisfactory in accord with the standards of good discipline.

**CITIZENSHIP--SPECIFICS:**

The student must have no incident of drug or alcohol use and/or abuse during any activity associated with a Parkway School. A violation will result in automatic removal of the student from the Parkway A+ Program. The student must adhere to a code of behavior that will demonstrate respect for authority, faculty, school property, and their fellow students. The school's printed discipline policy will serve as the definition of appropriate behavior. Specific information can be found in the school handbook and district policy manual.
