

Kindergarten Registration for the 2024-2025 School Year

ENROLLMENT BEGINS JANUARY 4, 2024

Missouri law states that students must be 5 years old before the first day of August to enroll in Kindergarten



Our Kindergarten is a full-day, tuition-free program.


