

Counselor's Corner

Going Back to School After Winter Break

For many preschoolers this is the first time returning to school after a long break. To get back into your routine:

- Review your usual routine. "What do we do first before school? Then what is next?" etc.
- Make sure your child realizes that everyone in the family is going back to the routine & they won't be "missing out" on anything at home.
- Remind your child that they will be in the same room, with the same friends and the same teacher. Talk about their favorite areas of the classroom.
- Ask your child to to tell you the rules of school that they remember & review together.
- Focus on the positives, but remember tomorrow is almost like the first day of school again.
- Let your child know....
