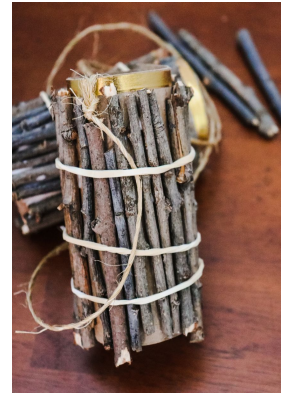




Binocular Craft for Seeing Signs of Spring!



All you will need:

- 2 toilet paper rolls or 1 paper towel roll cut in half
- Any kind of tape
- Glue or glue stick
- String or twine, an old shoelace
- Scissors
- Materials for decorating: paint, colored papers, markers, stickers, sticks or leaves, etc

Making your binoculars:

- Tape the 2 rolls together at top and bottom or in the middle
- If desired, wrap additional paper around both rolls and tape (for larger decoration space)
- Decorate your binos by gluing on leaves, sticks, cut-outs from paper, color with markers, with stickers, paint, or any materials you like
- Poke 1 hole into each roll at bottom (your pick) on outside. Put string-object through holes and tie off so binos can be worn around neck
- Have fun outside looking for signs of spring!
