Criteria:

- Student's first and last name need to be on every envelope
- ONLY SEND CARDS & LETTERS NO GIFTS OR OTHER ITEMS!
- Cards and letters should be no larger than 8.5 X 11 inches.
- Cards and letters should be flat.
- Do not send anything of value (ex: cash, check, gift card). We cannot be responsible for it.
- Packages cannot be accepted.
- If small envelopes are sent inside a large envelope, write the student's full name on all the envelopes.

In order to ensure that every student receives at least 2 letters, ALL CARDS AND LETTERS MUST ARRIVE AT THE SCHOOL NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MARCH 16, 2023. Please send in your letters as early as possible.
