After School Supervision

After School Detention


Tardiness or Skipping class will result in a 3-hour after school detention

Chronic tardiness can result in removal from after school activity privileges and possibly being put on a no travel plan.

Cell phone usage at North

- -There is a building policy RED, Yellow, GREEN Policy
- -Do not allow your phone to be a distraction
- -The first time I have to confiscate your phone, you may receive it back during your assigned lunch time or by the end of the day depending on if the phone was confiscated in the AM or PM

Parkway has 18 Discipline Standards

Principal's Suspension- Up to 10 days

Violation of this standards can result to <u>In School Suspension</u>, <u>Principal's</u> or <u>Superintendent's</u>
Suspension

Superintendent's Suspension- From 11 days to 180 days

Suspensions still exist !!!

- Standard 1. Causing Disruption of School or Any School Function
- <u> Standard 2. Damaging School Property or Property of Others</u>
- Standard 3. Stealing or Possessing the Property of the District or Others without Authorization
- Standard 4. Making Inappropriate Physical Contact, Inciting a Fight, Fighting or Assaulting Others
- Standard 5. Harassing, Bullying, Threatening, Hazing or Intimidating Others
- Standard 6. Committing Sexual Harassment or Other Sexual Misconduct
- Standard 7. Possessing, Using, Distributing, Selling or Being under the Influence of Alcohol, Controlled
- Substances, or Imitation Controlled Substances or Tobacco Products
- Standard 8. Being Disrespectful
- <u>Standard 9. Being Insubordinate</u>
- Standard 10. Possessing Firearms and Weapons
- Standard 11. Posing a Threat of Harm to Himself/Herself or Others at School, as Evidenced by Prior Conduct
- Standard 12. Possessing Bombs or Other Dangerous Substances
- <u> Standard 13. Making False Alarms or False Bomb Reports</u>
- Standard 14. Setting Fires
- Standard 15. Misuse of Network Access, Internet Access, or Electronic Equipment
- Standard 16. Being Charged, Convicted or Pleading Guilty to Commission of a Felony in a Court of General
- Jurisdiction or Being Registered on the Missouri Sex Offender Registry
- Standard 17. Being Charged, Convicted, or Pleading Guilty to Certain Serious Felonies
- Standard 18. Engaging in Other Serious Misconduct

Chromebook Care

- 1. Behave responsibly on your Chromebook-It is not for personal use

- 2. Handle your Chromebook with care-Make good choices with your Chromebook

AcLab is 4th Hour

During Academic Lab

- AcLab is broken into 4 sections:
 - AcLab advisory (9:10 9:25 am)
 - Priority 1 (9:30 10:00 am)
 - Priority 2 (10:05 10:35 am)
 - Return to AcLab advisory
- To travel you must have a signed AcLab card dictating which teacher you will be travel to.
 - Your card must then be signed by that teacher upon your return.
 - Failure to go where you card indicates will result in loss of travel privileges.





E-hall Pass

- E-hall pass is an online system that is used to manage all pass situations.
- E-hall pass will replace paper passes and other forms of traditional passes.
- You will log into e-hall pass and request a pass from your teacher, which they will have the option to approve.
- You will log into e-hall pass through Clever
 - This application is available in your Google waffle
- Having your Chromebook with you is incredibly important to accessing your passes for the day.




