President's Report: Jenn Gibbs

- Open Board and Committee Positions: We discussed the openings and possible people to fill them.
 - Board: President
 - Committee: Lost/Found, Homecoming, Book Fair, Cotillion, Fundraising
 - Fundraising is particularly needed. We're under \$6000 this year.

Committee Reports/Upcoming Events

- Fundraising:
 - o Jr. Longhorn Spirit Campaign: need to push through remainder of school year.
 - Mailer sent; gave a boost.
 - May need to publicize how much of the money goes to staff and how much goes to kids.
 - o The money for LEAD goes to kids.
 - Jr. Longhorn Spirit Nights:
 - 2/26 Noodles & Company—Clarkson/Baxter
- Box Tops for Education:
 - Next collection: 2/14
 - o Would like a push notification to go out on Wednesday

• Spiritwear:

- Next opportunity to buy (in-person)—Conference Nights (2/21 and 2/26). Still looking for volunteers to help sell (4-7 pm).
- Remind people before conferences.
- We have good ideas on what does well and what to order

• Conference Dinners:

- Sign-ups went out; filling up, but could use a volunteer for setup each night
- Sign-ups were somewhat confusing for some people, because you have to scroll far down for the correct date.
- Some people sign up to bring items and then don't, which leaves the organizers scrambling.

• 7th Grade Cotillion:

- Classes begin 4/4
- Still looking for males.
- o Final event (dinner) is on May 4th

• 8th Grade Celebration:

- o Planning is underway
- o Vendors have been secured
- Need to buy spiritwear for 8th grade celebration at cost

Treasurer's Report: Michael Bertz

- PTO's finances are in good order.
- We continue to make progress but are still running a little behind on fundraising
- Tax breaks may be a problem: with the increase in the Standard Deduction, many families may not itemize and so not see tax benefits from donating
- Major expense categories (socials, 8th grade celebration) are starting to pick up
- Currently approximately \$31,960 in bank accounts, not including about \$4400 in our PayPal account (\$2445 Spiritwear and \$1950 Jr. Longhorn)
- Jr. Longhorn and Spiritwear sales continue to grow
- FY 18-19 Budget:
 - Running a little bit behind in many categories, even smaller ones like restaurant nights/food sales
 - Operating budget relatively stable overall at about \$16,000. We have only spent about \$4400 so far. A couple of categories may slightly exceed their amounts.

• Jr. Longhorn

- Separate expense category: \$465 on postcards and postage. That drove a surge of year-end donations
- Currently at \$6303.03
- Over halfway to last year's total but only 45% of this year's goal
