Treasurer's Report: Michael and Gretchen Bertz

- Current balance of \$25,454 in bank accounts. This doesn't include approximately \$1000 in our PayPal account and \$4113.50 in transfer from SpirtWear, Jr. Longhorn, and Buzz Books.
- FY 17-18 summary:
 - o Finished in June very close to projected budget.
 - Fundraising total was \$36,701 (projected \$36250), Expenses total was \$37,655 (projected \$38,775).
 - Exceeded projected fundraising in Jr. Longhorn (So Simple), Buzz Books, and Spirit Wear.

- Did not meet projected fundraising in Food Sales and Schoola. Underspent on the expense side.
- We should project a budget surplus to make sure expenses are covered.
- One increased expense in recent years is the LEAD initiative.
- For FY 18-19, we propose increasing fundraising with a goal of \$45,000. The main increases would come from the Jr. Longhorn (So Simple) fundraiser and a new event with a target of \$5000, perhaps a parent social event.
- The FY 18-19 operating budget is good.
- The Longhorn Pride budget is for the Bond Campaign. The money will be disbursed soon.
- We would like to confirm the expected level of support for the LEAD program by the PTO for this year and future years.

New Business: Parkway's Bond Issue will be voted on in November. They need volunteers to knock on doors.

Next Meeting will be October 9th at 7 pm in the West Middle Library.
