Guest Speaker, Carter Snow

- Generally assessments are designed for in person evaluation
- May find blanks where data is not provided or easy to acquire w/ comments



- "Not observed" or "insufficient information" may be encountered when teacher could not acquire data, Relationship skills, for example is more difficult to observe
- Local assessments (units, gifted screenings- in person)
- State assessments
 - Access starting soon, state mandated, no virtual options
 - We have to ask students to come in
 - Families may refuse
 - MAP 3rd-5th, no virtual option
 - Working to determine approach and communication
 - Respecting family right to refuse
 - State of Mo is interested in the impact of pandemic on learners
 - Results lag, not ready to Fall
 - In person learners won't represent population as a whole
 - 95% participation rate required in a normal year, not expecting to be at that rate this year
 - State will not tell us what the implications will be if we are below that rate
 - Will not be used for accountability
 - Will not negatively effect student if they do not participate
 - Ms. Lackey, would trust district assessments more to identify impact of the pandemic
