Grade: 9-11 BEG JOURNLSM 1/2 Elective Credit Prerequisite: None

Students will learn basic journalism skills necessary to be successful in Newspaper 1 and Yearbook 1. Curriculum includes, but is not limited to, vocabulary, writing, editing, layout/design, desktop publishing, the use of different software programs and the history of newsprint journalism. Writing will focus on news writing, feature writing and sports writing.

This course continues to build upon the basics of journalism as presented in Beginning Journalism. It expands to include a more advanced study of design/layout and participation in production of the school yearbook and photography. Students begin the exploration of scholastic journalism and the law as well as current issues in scholastic and professional journalism.
