- > You also may pick up your child upon our return to school. Please utilize both the north and south lots and wait for your child in a parking spot. Please do not create carpool lines.

#### Additional Notes:

- > Students will be able to purchase a lunch using their own cash or the food voucher purchased from the school store. No food is allowed to be brought into Six Flags. (We strongly recommend students not bring large sums of money into the park.)
- > Cell phones and other technological devices are the responsibility of each student. (Bring at own risk.)
- > Hurricane Harbor will be closed; therefore, students should not wear swimsuits.



### PARKWAY NORTHEAST MIDDLE SCHOOL




