#### Activity:

Mad Lib story - Have a room helper get words for the blanks of the mad lib story (other room helpers help with prepping the slime and hanging up the spider web during this time)

#### Craft:

**2) Slime** - room parents put slim ingredients in a Dixie cup with a popsicle stick for kids to stir. Kids add their own googly eyes and other creepy crawlers.

#### Games:

#### Split the class into half. Each half does the below activity and then swaps:

- **3) Wrap the Mummy:** split the kids into groups of 3 or 4 and one child volunteers to be wrapped in toilet paper. The other 2 or 3 kids each get a roll of toilet paper to wrap.
- **4)** Plastic Spider Toss: toss as many plastic ring spiders as possible into a web within 30 seconds. Each child gets to keep 5 spider rings after games are over.

#### Everyone back in one group:

5) Kids dance to "Thriller" URL <a href="https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZhflzGDiDIM">https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ZhflzGDiDIM</a> while parents clean up from the crafts (teachers, can this be queued up and ready please)

#### Craft:

6) Decorate a foam pumpkin using foam stickers

#### Activities:

- 7) Read the Mad Lib story
- 8) Read a book, *Room on the Broom* or something similar

## Making Slime:

Ingredients: liquid Elmer's glue, liquid Tide (ratio 2:1), food coloring & creepy crawlers

Parent Helpers pass out one Dixie cup per child while the Mad Lib game has started (there are 20-21 children per class, ask the teacher before starting):



#### **Directions**

• Place paper towel square in front of each kid for placemat and cleanup ease

- Place the popsicle stick in the cup for easy measuring. Pour the glue to the first line and the detergent on top to the second line (appx 1 ounce, ~2 tablespoons, glue and half an ounce, ~1 tablespoon. detergent)
- o Add 2 small drops of food coloring (~ size of pencil eraser in total) in Dixie cup.
- Mix with popsicle stick, then take out and squish/knead with hands until slime is no longer wet.
- Add googly eyes and other creepy crawlers (appx 5 per child)
- Put the slime into ziplock bags to take home
- Give each child a hand wipe



## Wrap the Mummy

Split the class in half. One half does this game while the other half does the Spider Toss.

In groups of 3 or 4, one child volunteers to be wrapped in toilet paper. The other 2 or 3 children each get their own roll off toilet paper. Take pictures (as long as it's OK to photograph the group, check with the teacher if there is anyone in the class that isn't allowed to get their photo taken).



### **Spider Toss**

Split the class in half. One half does this game while the other half does the Mummy Wrap.

Line up the appx 10 children. One room helper will have hung up a spider web during the mad libs. One at a time, each child will catapult a plastic spider on a spoon by holding the spoon down by the handle while, with the other hand, pushing the spoon face down. Let go and catapult the object as far as possible away from the spoon. The goal is to get as many plastic ring spiders as possible into a web within 30 seconds to see how many stick to the web (use a sand timer or a stopwatch). Each child gets to keep 5 spider rings after all games are over.
