Types of Virtual Courses

CREDIT RECOVERY

Credit Recovery courses are designed for students who have taken the course previously and failed.

These courses are offered in-person and online through Launch, Parkway's preferred, third-party online provider.

CREDIT ADVANCEMENT

Credit Advancement courses are designed for students who are taking the course for the first time.

These courses are only offered online only.



In-Person Credit Recovery Course Schedule

In-Person Credit Recovery courses are scheduled in Periods 1 & 2 in your Infinite Campus schedule. Courses begin **June 13, 2022**.

Period 1 courses meet from 7:30-10:15 a.m.

Period 2 courses meet from 10:45-1:30 p.m.

Launch Virtual Credit Recovery & Credit Advancement Course Schedule

Virtual Credit Recovery & Credit Advancement courses through Launch are scheduled in Periods 1 & 2 in your Infinite Campus schedule.

Credit Advancement Course Schedule

Credit Advancement courses are scheduled in Period 3 in your Infinite Campus schedule.

Credit Advancement students must attend a check-in meeting with the instructor the first week of the summer term. Teachers will communicate the meeting dates/times through Schoology. There will be several meeting options available.

All other work will be completed asynchronously and there will not be daily class meetings or live instruction.

Credit Advancement Courses

- Credit advancement courses are not self-paced; they begin on June 13 and end on July 15
- Students will have deadlines for finishing and turning in assignments
- Credit advancement courses require that you complete readings, written exercises, papers, research assignments, case studies and tests -- just as you would in an in-person course
- Credit advancement courses may require that you participate in discussion forums and chats or work with a group of learners on a project, just as you might in an in-person course

Credit Advancement Courses

In synchronous or in-person courses, you meet at a set time each day. In addition, you spend time outside of class reading and doing assignments. In an asynchronous course, you will also need to spend time in class activities, but you will be responsible for scheduling that time into your calendar. One of the benefits of an asynchronous course is that you will choose when to access the course and how long to spend on it.

Time management is a critical element of success for online learners.

Time Management

Since you are responsible for your time in an online course, you may need to develop some new habits:

- Make sure you have a set schedule before starting the course
- Set aside a specific time each day of every week that you will spend on your online course.
- Log on every day or as many times a week as you can
- Do a little bit of work each time you log on. This works better than trying to log on once in awhile and doing everything at once.
- Your instructor will provide you with assignment calendars to guide you with planning your weekly work.
- Check your Parkway email frequently.

Time Management

If you will be out of town or unavailable at any time during the course, please work with your instructor ***ahead of time*** to make arrangements for ensuring your assignments are completed.

Student work cannot be accepted after July 15, 2022.

integrity

Parkway seeks to maintain the highest level of academic integrity and expects students to act in a responsible manner at all times. Students taking online courses will follow the same guidelines for academic integrity as outlined in their student handbook. It is essential that virtual students work through each assignment in the course and take the course assessments independently.

Grading and Access to Grades

Online instructors will explain their grading policy in the syllabus provided at the beginning of the course. A student's grade can be accessed at any time in Infinite Campus.

Drop Policy

Students must log-in to their virtual course(s) by **June 17, 2022**. Students who fail to do so will be automatically dropped from the course on June 18, 2022 and will not be able to re-enroll during the summer term.

Students may choose to drop their online course(s) by **June 19, 2022** without penalty. Any drops beyond that date will result in an “NC” on their transcript for the course.
